For example, please pass me the "f-or-k" and then ask your child to blend the sounds and then encourage them to say "fork". This can work with anything in the home.	Phonic games Play a phonics hunt. Can you find/point to something beginning with 'r' - remote, 'ch' - chair, 't' - teddy etc... Play 'I Spy...' "I spy something that has the 'oi' sound in... c-oi-n".	Silly sentences We read and write silly sentences all of the time. These are sentences that don't make sense but have a focus sound in or rhyming words. "I went to the park and took a bat." "I went to the park and took a bat and a cat." "I went to the park and took a bat, a cat and a hat."
