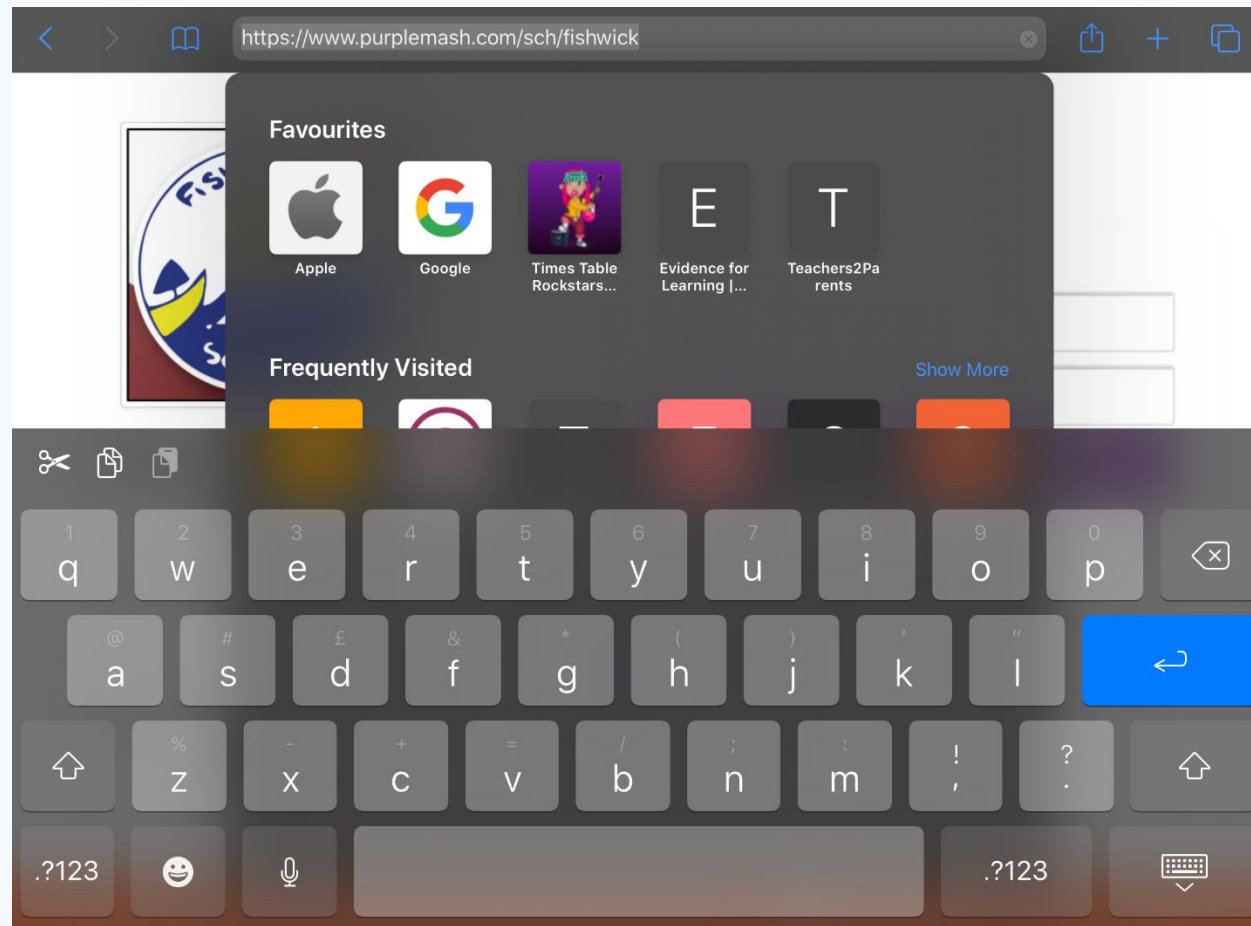





How to log in to Purple Mash
