Writing

Plan a space picnic on the moon. What would you eat at the picnic? Make a menu showing the different yummy foods that you could take with you. Write food name labels under the pictures. You could also make invitations to invite friends and family to the picnic.

Remember to encourage the use of phonics to write words or a simple sentence.

Science

The moon has craters on the surface - what is a crater? How are craters made? Can you create your own craters? Mix 4 cups of cornflour and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of baby oil together to form a moon sand mixture. Drop different pebbles into the mixture to create different sized craters. If the pebble is dropped from different heights, does this make a difference to the crater? Does the size of a pebble make a difference for the size of the crater?
